*All events will be from a stakeboat start. There will be 4-lane side-by-side time trials, whereby the fastest times across all races in an event will be seeded into ABCD finals. Depending on entry size, these may be sub-divided into "Championship" and "Plate" categories as follows.*

### **Important Notes**

1. All entries to be submitted through BROE.
2. Entries close at **22:00 on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> June** unless closed earlier due to oversubscription.
3. The draw will take place on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> June and will be released by **22:00 on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June**
4. Entry Fee: £15 per head (excluding coxes) payable via BROE ONLY
5. Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> positions in all "A" Finals (including Plate events)
6. The Victor Ludorum Shield will be awarded to the most successful club over the 2 days
7. No spectators permitted other than coaches, a parent or guardian of competitors
8. No refreshments will be available, **make sure you bring plenty of food and drink** for personal consumption
9. There is no overnight camping available
10. Competitors will be asked to leave the site as soon as their racing is finished

**Primary Conditions of Entry** (further Competitor Instructions & Conditions will be made available at a later date)

1. Competitors, coaches & guardians agree to abide by all Government & British Rowing Covid-19 Guidance in place at the time of the competition including social distancing, hygiene & will have actively carried out a self-assessment health check prior to attending. If anyone shows signs of COVID-19 before the event they should not attend. If someone develops symptoms on the day, they and their household/crew/group members should leave immediately and inform the COVID-19 Officer via phone.
2. Each entering club must give a single point of contact to act as their Covid-19 Liaison. This person must be present whilst your crews are on site and will act as the conduit for the dissemination of any Covid-19 related information
3. Spectators must be strongly discouraged from attending by their own club. Clubs may be asked to leave the Competition & entries withdrawn without refund if it is found that supporters are on site as a result of the regatta. Guardians of juniors are permitted.
4. All attendees should follow the 'self-sufficiency' guidance as set out in British Rowing's Managing Covid-19 guidance.
5. Competitors & support staff/guardians will be expected to base themselves in their own vehicles when not preparing to race, racing, or de-boating. You should not gather in crowd forming groups.
6. Competitors & support staff/guardians will be expected to wear face coverings at all times when moving around the site, these may be removed once seated in a boat.
7. Should the regatta need to be cancelled either before or during the competition on the grounds of safety or instruction from statutory authorities with regard to Covid-19, the regatta will endeavour to make a partial refund of entry fees once accurate costs have been calculated.
