4-lane time trials seeding 4-lane ABCD finals

Due to the success of this format in our regattas this year, our traditional knockout style has been replaced with 4-lane time trials, which will seed crews into respective ABCD finals. Depending on entry size, events may be sub-divided into "Championship" and "Plate" categories. This gives crews two opportunities to race and produces the best side-by-side racing possible.

Important Notes

- 1. All entries to be submitted through BROE.
- 2. Entries close at **22:00 on Saturday 7th August** but may be suspended earlier if oversubscribed.
- 3. The Draw will take place on Sunday 8th August and will be released by **22:00 on Monday 9th August**.
- 4. Entry Fee: £15 per head (excluding coxes) payable via BROE ONLY.
- 5. Doubling up between Divisions is permitted, but NOT within a Division.
- 6. Masters events will be handicapped in accordance with BR's rules of racing.
- 7. Pewter tankards for all Final-A winners in both "Championship" and "Plate" events.
- 8. All events will be from a stakeboat start.
- 9. The Victor Ludorum Shield will be awarded to the most successful club over the 2 days.

- 11. Further updates regarding the general operation of the regatta will be confirmed once revised guidance from the Government and British Rowing is released.
- 12. Competitors will be expected to leave the site as soon as their racing is finished.

Primary Conditions of Entry (further Competitor Instructions & Conditions will be made available at a later date)

- 1. Competitors, coaches & guardians agree to abide by all Government & British Rowing Covid-19 Guidance in place at the time of the competition including social distancing, hygiene & will have actively carried out a self-assessment health check prior to attending. If anyone shows signs of COVID-19 before the event they should not attend. If someone develops symptoms on the day, they and their household/crew/group members should leave immediately and inform the COVID-19 Officer via phone.
- 2. Spectators must be strongly discouraged from attending by their own club. Clubs may be asked to leave the Competition & entries withdrawn without refund if it is found that supporters are on site as a result of the regatta. Guardians of juniors are permitted.
- 3. All attendees should follow the 'self-sufficiency' guidance as set out in British Rowing's Managing Covid-19 guidance.
- 4. Competitors & support staff/guardians will be expected to base themselves in their own vehicles when not preparing to race, racing, or de-boating. You should not gather in crowd forming groups.
- 5. It is recommended that all competitors & support staff/guardians wear face coverings at all times when moving around the site, these may be removed once seated in a boat.
- 6. Should the regatta need to be cancelled either before or during the competition on the grounds of safety or instruction from statutory authorities with regard to Covid-19, the regatta will endeavour to make a partial refund of entry fees once accurate costs have been calculated.
