Important Notes

- 1. All entries and payments to be made through BROE.
- 2. Entries open at 09:00 on Sunday 26th September
- 3. Entries close at **12:00 (noon) on Sunday 24th October** unless closed earlier on an event or division basis due to oversubscription.
- 4. The draw will take place on Sunday 24th October, coordinated from PCRC and will be released on our website by 22:00 that day.
- 5. Pewter tankards will be awarded to the fastest crew in each event, where three or more crews have entered.
- 6. Please follow any national, local and British Rowing guidance regarding COVID security in place at the time of the competition.
- 7. On-site catering will be available around the boating area throughout the day.
- 8. Competitors are encouraged to leave the site as soon as their racing has finished.
- 9. The Organising Committee reserve the right to alter the course or remove certain events due to adverse weather conditions.

Primary Conditions of Entry (further Competitor Instructions & Conditions will be made available at a later date)

- Competitors, coaches & guardians agree to abide by all Government & British Rowing
 Covid-19 Guidance in place at the time of the competition including social distancing,
 hygiene & will have actively carried out a self-assessment health check prior to
 attending. If anyone shows signs of COVID-19 before the event they should not attend.
 If someone develops symptoms on the day, they and their household/crew/group
 members should leave immediately and inform the COVID-19 Officer via phone.
- Should the Head need to be cancelled either before or during the competition on the grounds of safety or instruction from statutory authorities with regard to COVID-19, we will endeavour to make a partial refund of entry fees once accurate costs have been calculated.
- 3. The race is upstream and usually into a head wind, all crews who enter must be of sufficient competency to race in these conditions.
- 4. For Juniors:
 - a. J15 events: Only open to J15s; J14s are not permitted to race up
 - b. J16 events: J15s may enter
 - c. J18 events: J17 and above may enter
- 5. Where necessary, Masters events may be combined and race times adjusted using the British Rowing handicapping system.
- 6. For larger events, we may use BROE's CRI to band these into smaller categories.
