Crew progression will be as follows based on the number of entries in each event

Entry count	Progression format
1-4 crews	Final
5 crews	1 Heat → Final
6-8 crews	2 Heats → Final
9-12 crews	3 Heats → 1 Rep → Final
13-16 crews	4 Heats → 2 Semis → Final

Banding based on CRI may be used for large events.

Important Notes

1. All entries to be submitted through BROE.
2. Entries close at **22:00 on Saturday 23rd May** but may be suspended earlier if oversubscribed.
3. Entries in any one event may have to be limited at the discretion of the organising committee if there is a very high level of demand, a waiting list will be setup accordingly.
4. The Draw will take place on Sunday 24th May and will be released by **22:00 on Monday 25th May**.
5. Entry Fee: £18 per seat (excluding coxes) payable via BROE ONLY.
6. Doubling up between Divisions is permitted, but NOT within a Division.
7. Where applicable, Masters events will be handicapped in accordance with BR's Rules of Racing. Please provide notes on BROE if there is an alternative event you would wish to race in should there be insufficient entries in your chosen event.
8. Pewter tankards for all winning competitors.
9. All events will be from a stakeboat start (subject to weather conditions).
10. The Victor Ludorum Shield will be awarded to the most successful club over the 2 days.
